## MANNA



In a recent survey, conducted by the Canadian Bible Forum, a group of nine Christian agencies with the assistance of 'Angus Reid Strategies', revealed alarming statistics regarding Bible reading and engagement. Four thousand, five hundred people across Canada were involved in the study. It is the most recent and comprehensive study of its kind. The appraisal exposed that over-all, most Canadians are not reading and are not interested in reading their Bibles. "Since 1996, weekly Bible reading has declined by 60% and only 14% of Canadians actually read the Bible at least once a month." Bible reading and engagement have an undeniable correlation with church attendance and biblical-living. Both have seen decline in Canada. We cannot afford to neglect the daily reading and engagement of God's Word. I can't help but think of the many people who lost their lives in history to ensure that we could have a copy of the Bible in our possession. Jesus said: "***Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God.***" (Matt. 4: 4)
