JUST FOR KIDS

Our children join us for worship in the main Sanctuary until they are called to the altar area for prayer. They will then attend Sunday School and will be supervised by our capable workers. Their special Bible lesson will conclude at the same time as the adult service.

On the first Sunday of each month (Communion Sunday) our children will stay with their parents in the main sanctuary for the entire service. Nursery will function as usual and be available every Sunday.

Nursery is supervised and available when the children are dismissed from the sanctuary.

The Cross of Christ is the center of Biblical Christianity. We view it from two different but linked perspectives. We receive it in one way and respond to it in another way. The Ministry from the Cross is what we receive; as in our atonement and healing. His death was vicarious; He died for us, so that we could be reconciled back to the Creator. Our inherited, fallen natures left us separated from the eternal-life which is only found in God. Christ's work on the Cross has made it possible for us to be redeemed by faith in Christ.

The Message from the Cross is something we respond to. Its message is a calling to self-sacrifice. We hear Jesus say ***"Come follow me"***; a savior who gave everything for others. It is the ministry and message of the Cross that Paul has in mind when he is encouraging the Philippians to put each other first. *"If you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any fellowship with the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, then ...Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others (ahead of yourself)" (Phil. 2)*
