JUST FOR KIDS

Our children join us for worship in the main Sanctuary until they are called to the altar area for prayer. They will then attend Sunday School and will be supervised by our capable workers. Their special Bible lesson will conclude at the same time as the adult service.

On the first Sunday of each month (Communion Sunday) our children will stay with their parents in the main sanctuary for the entire service. Nursery will function as usual and be available every Sunday.

Nursery is supervised and available when the children are dismissed from the sanctuary.

“Lord, You have been our dwelling place throughout all generations. Before the mountains were born or you brought forth the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God. You turn men back to dust, saying, ‘return to dust, O sons of men.’ For a thousand years in your sight are like a day that has just gone by, or like a watch in the night. You sweep men away in the sleep of death; they are like the new grass of the morning-though in the morning it springs up new, by evening it is dry and withered. We are consumed by your anger and terrified by your indignation. You have set our iniquities before you, our secret sins in the light of your presence. All our days pass away under your wrath; we finish our years with a moan. The length of our days is seventy years-or eighty, if we have the strength; yet their span is but trouble and sorrow, for they quickly pass, and we fly away. Who knows the power of your anger? For your wrath is as great as the fear that is due you. Teach us to number our days aright, that we may gain a heart of wisdom...May the favor of the Lord our God rest upon us; establish the work of our hands for us-yes, establish the work of our hands.” (Psalm 90)

The Holy Spirit gave Moses incredible insight into God's eternal heart. He sees God's inevitable wrath against the sin of humanity. God's wrath is stirred because unrighteousness destroys us. Sin brought death to the human race; our length of days is pitiable compared to Eternity. In light of all this truth Moses cries out to God: ‘Teach us to number our days aright...establish the work of our hands’. The work of Moses' hands was the continuing formation of a new nation, Israel. Christ would come through her; the magnificent, eternal ‘dwelling place’ for all believers. God, through Christ is now forming an unstoppable spiritual nation; the eternal Body of Christ!
