## JUST FOR KIDS

Our children join us for worship in the main Sanctuary until they are called to the altar area for prayer. They will then attend Sunday School and will be supervised by our capable workers. Their special Bible lesson will conclude at the same time as the adult service.

*"Of old you laid the foundation of the earth, and the heavens are the work of your hands. They will perish, but you will remain; they will all wear out like a garment. You will change them like a robe, and they will pass away, but you are the same, and your years have no end". (Ps. 102: 25-27)*

Could the environmental break down that we are witnessing and are constantly warned about, be the "wearing out" of Creation that the Psalmist saw prophetically, thousands of years ago?
