**On the first Sunday of each month (Communion Sunday) our children will stay with their parents in the main sanctuary for the entire service. Nursery will function as usual and be available every Sunday.**

We thank God for another wonderful **Summer Explosion Day Camp**. We appreciate the great effort that our staff put forward, led capably by our Team Leader, Allie Colwell. The camp runs eight weeks and includes a multitude of activities, games, crafts, devotionals, films, pool trips, and eight bus excursions to points of interest. We had one hundred and three children enrolled this summer, thirteen volunteers, four counsellors, and one team leader. Patricia and Pastor Mills provide planning, administration, and oversight. We appreciate the many positive comments and emails we have received from parents and guardians. This year we are donating five dollars from every registration to help children in Bangladesh. This will be done through "Emergency Relief and Development Overseas" (ERDO). The Canadian Government is matching our contribution four to one, making a total donation of \$2,575.00.
