In Mark chapter 9: 1-13 we have the amazing account of what we call the "transfiguration". The only disciples there to see it were Peter, James, and John; so it is believed that Peter related the account to Mark as one of the eyewitness'. The miraculous event is also recorded in Matt. and Luke, and alluded to in 2 Peter 1: 16-18 and John 1:14. No one should quickly dismiss the enormous importance of what these holy men saw and heard on that mountain. They actually saw Jesus, flanked by two extremely important godly figures of the past, (Moses and Elijah) transformed temporarily into what the world will see when He comes again. Mark and Peter make sure that we know that He said it would happen six days before. He said only some standing here would see this spectacular glimpse of what the Kingdom of God will look like when it comes. They saw Jesus' face begin to shine with divine glory and even His clothes were transformed into a whiteness never seen before. Moses had physically died and Elijah was transported into God's presence before death but both of them appeared. It is a testimony to the fact that whether alive or deceased when time ceases to be, the faithful in Christ will be transformed and with Him. We worship a living, coming, Savior and when we see Him face to face some day we will understand more fully what these three disciples saw and why they could never stop talking about it. "Maranatha"
