JUST FOR KIDS

Our children join us for worship in the main Sanctuary until they are called to the altar area for prayer. They will then attend Sunday School and will be supervised by our capable workers. Their special Bible lesson will conclude at the same time as the adult service.

On the first Sunday of each month (Communion Sunday) our children will stay with their parents in the main sanctuary for the entire service. Nursery will function as usual and be available every Sunday.

Nursery is supervised and available when the children are dismissed from the sanctuary.

"But as God is faithful, our word to you was not Yes and No. For the Son of God, Jesus Christ, who was preached among you by us-by me, Silvanus, and Timothy –was not Yes and No, but in Him was Yes. For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us. Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and has anointed us is God, who also has sealed us and given us the Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee." (2 Cor. 1: 18-22)

Our faith in God through Christ literally shapes our lives. The message we received about Christ was not a maybe, a no, but an absolute YES and an absolute AMEN. Every promise God made to fallen man through the Patriarchs and the Prophets is fulfilled in Christ alone. Our faith in His Work, His Victory, and His Presence initiates a renovation in our lives. God calls us to a Yes, Amen outlook in Christ. Amen means "yes, I believe it". The Scripture declares that we are anointed and sealed by the Holy Spirit to produce a continued fruitfulness.
