### Biblical Faith Shapes Our Lives

#### Theme Verse: 2 Corinthians 1: 18-22

*"But as God is faithful, our word to you was not Yes and No. For the Son of God, Jesus Christ, who was preached among you by us-by me, Silvanus, and Timothy -was not Yes and No, but in Him was Yes. For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us. Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and has anointed us is God, who also has sealed us and given us the Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee."*

Our faith in God through Christ literally shapes our lives. The message we received about Christ was not a maybe, a no, but an absolute YES and an absolute AMEN. Part of what godly faith creates in our redeemed hearts is a growing ANTICIPATION and EXPECTATION in God. God is not motionless and stationary in anyway; He is patient and long suffering but that does not mean that he is not always moving forward. He has a massive plan and it is working out every second in the lives of His redeemed children. What anticipation and expectation has God planted in your heart? What in Christ are you hoping for; what are you moving towards. What is it that you see in the Spirit which has not yet manifest in the physical? Godly anticipation moves us toward something. It sets a path before us, it makes us more intentional, and it creates goals and purpose in our lives. But there are hindrances to this type of faith. I will be looking at those obstacles today and dealing with how we overcome in Christ.
