Constitutional Qualifications for the office of Board of Deacons

Any person may be considered for election to the Board of Deacons, provided he or she fulfills all of the following qualifications:

- they must be an Active Member of the Church in good standing practicing regular church attendance and the faithful giving of tithes for a minimum of two years
- they must be twenty-one years of age or older
- they must be personally committed to Jesus Christ as Saviour and Lord and give evidence thereof
- they must have active involvement within the Church
- they must fulfill the spiritual qualifications of an overseer as listed in 1 Timothy 3:1-7, Titus 1:5-10 and 1 Peter 5:1-5
- they must agree to uphold and be subject to the Church Constitution
- they must recognize that membership on the Board of Deacons is a commitment to humble service, not a position of honour or status, nor a reward for past service
- they cannot be a paid employee of the Church or be providing paid services to the Church as either a dependent or independent contractor
- they must abide by the Deacon Covenant as duly signed

In order for the Nomination Ballot to be valid, you must print your own name on the first line where it says "I, _____ nominate" and write your signature on the bottom line. All Active Members are able to nominate three individuals fulfilling the qualifications listed above. Please return by September 24th.
